### National Night Out


**Tues. Aug 5th, 6—8:30 pm**

## National Night Out—Tues Aug 5th, 6 to 8:30 pm


The introduction of National Night Out, “America’s Night Out Against Crime”, in 1984 began an effort to promote involvement in crime prevention activities, police-community partnerships, neighborhood camaraderie and send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back. National Association of Town Watch’s National Night Out program culminates annually, on the first Tuesday of August.

NATW’s Executive Director, Matt Peskin introduced National Night Out in

1984. The first National Night Out took place on Tuesday, August 7th 1984. That first year, 2.5 million Americans took part across 400 communities in 23 states.

National Night Out now involves over 37.8 million people and 16,124 communities from all fifty states, U.S. Territories, Canadian cities, and military bases worldwide. San Rafael joined NNO three years ago; WENA joined last year.

The WENA “Block Party / Picnic” is held annually on Neame Street. They have been roaring successes. There were in excess of 100 attendees at all picnics - approaching 200 attendees last year.
