BOARD MEETING MINUTES
18 JUNE 2015

Call to Order: Gordon MacDermott, President, called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm at his home.

We need to be sure we don't block access for possible open house events. By 16 July **Dave Borton** will arrange insurance. We need to apply to the City so they can vote on approval of the street closure. **Ben** will contact Play Well regarding a Lego demo. **Vicki** will ask Shar for info on a face painter for her picnic. We discussed raffle prizes. **Chris** and **Gordy** did a great job last year. Hopefully they can again this year. We discussed possible Grand prizes. **Gordy** will check at Anchor Steam to see if something can be donated. **Vicki** will check with Deb Coburn re Owner's tickets for the Giants. These were great seats and were free! Another suggestion came in after the meeting: a night at The Pelican Inn. Food is included. We can discuss this at our **next meeting on 13 Aug.**

Holiday Party: Will be on 5 Dec and hosted by Jackie and Sam Moore. Next year we will have it on the north side of the neighborhood, and will resume alternating sides in future.
